After discussing the schedule with Howard and then Hans, the schedule has been revised as follows:

Estimated time line (with no speed bumps):

- Council approval of engineering SA3 on November 7, 2018.
- Hans will have completed construction plans ready for bidding within 30-45 days after Council approval. An updated Opinion of Probable Cost will follow shortly thereafter.
- Begin bid process December 2018.
- Entire bid process through award and contract/PO, 150 days.
- Contractor begins May 2019.
- Material ordering and mobilization, 30 days.
- Start construction June 2019.
- Construction/certification time frame, 120 days.
- Open Buckley's Pass for navigation October 2019.
